

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 57-83

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW
NO. 2-82 (SCHEDULE 12 - ONE WAY STREETS)

WHEREAS the Council deems it advisable to reopen Fraser Street between Main Street and Oak Street and to designate it as one-way.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws to open highways and for regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 198, as amended authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating traffic on highways.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Fraser Street as shown on Registered Plan No. 10 between Main Street and Oak Street in the City of North Bay hereby opened to vehicular traffic.
2. That Schedule 12 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 be amended by adding the following:
