

BY-LAW NO.1338

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the submission of a question to a vote of the Municipal Electors of the Corporation of the City of North Bay

WHEREAS The Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to submit to a vote of the Electors of the said Corporation a certain question under the provisions of Section 7, Sub-section 1 of the Local Government Extension Act, 1940 and to appoint a Day for the taking of such vote.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT there shall be submitted to the Electors of the City of North Bay the following question namely:

"Are you in favour as a Wartime measure under the Local Government Extension Act, 1940, of the Municipal Council elected for 1941, holding office, for the term of two years;?"

2. THAT the votes of the said Electors shall be taken on the said question at the following times and places and by the Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks, hereinafter named, that is to say:

THE Voting shall take place on the Second Day of December from (9) Nine A.M. until (6) Six P.M.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 22nd,1940

On the 26th Day of November at His Office in the Council Chamber, on Ferguson Street, in the City of North Bay at Two O'Clock in the afternoon the Mayor will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk of this Corporation and one person to attend each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of voting in the affirmative on the said question, and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of voting in the negative on the said question.

5. THE Fourth Day of Decemeber at the said Council Chamber at 12 O'Clock in the forenoon is hereby appointed as the time and place of s summing up by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of votes given in the affirmative and in the negative respectively.
