THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 91-89

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE FERGUSON STREET BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND MCINTYRE STREET.

WHEREAS, Section 208 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sub-Section 43, authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws to temporarily close any highway or portion of a highway during the construction, repairing or improvement of such highway.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That part of Ferguson Street between Main Street and McIntyre Street in the City of North Bay is hereby closed from 5 June 1989 to 7 July 1989 for the purpose of reconstruction and repair.
- 2. The Director of Engineering and Works shall provide and keep in repair a reasonable temporary alternative route for traffic and for all property owners who cannot obtain access to their property by reason of such closing.
- 3. That the Director of Engineering and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 5TH DAY OF JUNE, 1989. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 12TH DAY OF JUNE , 1989. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 12TH DAY OF JUNE , 1989.
