BKING a By-law to provide a Sinking Fund for the undertaking of a War Memorial in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS IT IS DEFINED fitting and advisable by the Corporation of the Town of North Bay to undertake a Memorial in commemotation of the war services of citizens of this Town and vicinity, during the World War, 1944 to 1918,

AND WHEREAS numerous citizens have expressed a desire to contribute to a fund for the erection of a War Memorial,

THEREFORE BE 1T KNACTED AND IT 1S HEREBY ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, as follows:-

- 1. That the Town of North Bay establish a Sinking Fund to be known as "THE MEMORIAL FUND", said Fund to be made up as follows:-
  - (a) Twenty Percent (20%) of moneys received annually from Police Court Fines, and Twenty Percent (20%) of Licenses annually payable under Municipal By-laws; also the sum of \$220.00, being amount received from G.W.V.A., in August, 1920, for license fees in connection with Polack Bros! Shows.
  - (b) Such sums as may be subscribed by private individuals, associations or companies, which shall be paid to the Town Treasurer to the credit of the Memorial Fund.
- 2. For any and all moneys so collected or subscribed, certificates shall be issued to individuals, companies or associations subscribing, signed by the Mayornand Treasurer of the Town of North Bay.
- 3. Said certificates will be transferable upon the books, which will be kept by the Treasurer of the Town off North Bay.
- 4. All holders of certificates, whose names are duly entered on the books above-mentioned, will be recognized as members of the "North Bay Memorial Fund Association."
- 5. The Mayor, the President of the Great War Veterans' Association, the Chairmen of the Finance, Contingent and Parks' Committees, and two members, elected annually by certificate-holders, shall be a Board of Management for the Fund, and for any undertaking of said Board.
- 6. It shall be the duty of the Board of Management to raise annually through payments above-mentioned, from the Town of North Bay, and through private subscriptions of otherwise, the amounts necessary to cover payments as they become due.
