THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 194-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE O'BRIEN STREET BETWEEN RAMSAY STREET AND FOSTER STREET.

WHEREAS, Section 208 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, sub-section 43, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws to temporarily close any highway or portion of a highway during the construction, repairing or improvement of such highway.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That part of O'Brien Street between Ramsay Street and
 Foster Street in the City of North Bay is hereby closed
 from October 15, 1986 to November 15, 1986 for the
 purpose of reconstruction and repair.
- 2. The City Engineer shall provide and keep in repair a reasonable temporary alternative route for traffic and for all property owners who cannot obtain access to their property by reason of such closing.
- 3. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
