## **GENERAL GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 2008-03**

March 17, 2008

TO THE COUNCIL

Your Worship and Councillors:

The General Government Committee presents **Report No. 2008-03** and recommends:

- 1. That the 2008 Operating Budget in the amount of \$103,221,761 (excluding water and sanitary sewer expenditures in the amount of \$15,182,600) with a resultant tax levy of \$62,953,981 as summarized on the attached Schedule A, be approved.
- 2. That budget adjustments summarized on the attached Schedule B, resulting in a net increase in the tax levy totaling \$678,956 from the Preliminary Operating Budget, be included in the Operating Budget.
- 3. That the Chief Financial Officer be authorized to process all transfers to and from reserve funds included in the 2008 Operating Budget, including a transfer of \$100,000 from the Tax Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund.
- 4. That the Chief Financial Officer be authorized to process the following year-end transfers to reserve funds as at December 31, 2007:
  - a. Merrick Landfill Reserve Fund \$150,000 (excess tipping fee revenues)
  - b. Police surplus to a new Police Purposes Reserve Fund \$323,272
  - c. Surplus distribution from local boards above amount budgeted (NDSSAB, Health Unit, Cassellholme)

    Tax Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund
  - d. And that any remaining year-end surplus (or deficit) be transferred to (from) the Tax Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund. The anticipated year-end surplus, subject to year-end audit, is under \$200,000
- 5. That the Chief Financial Officer be authorized to process a year-end accounting adjustment as at December 31, 2007 to record accrued vacation pay totaling \$1,248,000 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principals for local government as recommended by the Public Sector Accounting Board of the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants.

- 6. That the levies of all Agencies, Boards and Commissions totaling \$37,549,281 as summarized on the attached Schedule B, page #7 be included in the tax levy.
- 7. That the Chief Financial Officer be authorized to transfer \$5,750,000 from the Operating Fund to the Capital Fund to finance approved capital projects that would otherwise require debenture issuance to fund (Net Capital Levy in Operating Budget). This includes an additional \$1,000,000 added to expand the roadways resurfacing investment in 2008.
- 8. That the tax rates included on Schedule C be adopted for the 2008 taxation year.
- 9. That each final tax bill clearly discloses the amount included to subsidize provincial health and social programs as described by the Association of Municipalities of Ontario as "Ontario's \$3 Billion Provincial Municipal Fiscal Gap".
- 10. That the due date for the final property tax installment be set at June 30 for the 2008 taxation year.
- 11. That By-Law No.2008-57, arising from this report, be presented for three readings on March 17, 2008.
