BY-LAW No. 1390

BEING a by-law to amend Market By-Law of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend Market By-Law No. 849

and all amendments thereto.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT by-law no. 849 and all amendments thereto are amended by adding thereto sub-paragraph G of Section 5, as follows:
 - G. ALL eggs brought into the City Market to be graded and marked, according to the Government requirements of the regulations respecting the grading and packing and marking of eggs.
- 2. That by-law no. 849 and all amendments thereto are accordingly amended.
