BY-LAW NO. 1690.

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-law No. 1671, a By-law for the Revision of Salaries in the City of North Bay. WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that By-law No. 1671 be amended. THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 243 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ONTARIO AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Clause No. 1 of By-law No. 1671 be repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"1. THAT each duly elected Alderman of the City of North Bay shall be paid the annual remuneration of THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$350.00) which said sum shall be payable quarterly. Provided however, that there shall be a deduction of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) from each Alderman for each meeting of Council not attended by him and a further deduction of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) for each Committee Meeting not attended. Provided further, that in addition to the aforesaid, each Alderman be allowed an expense allowance of ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00)."

2. THAT the provisions herein be retroactive and that this By-law be effective as of the First day of January 1948.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 1ST DAY OF JUNE 1953. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 1ST DAY OF JUNE 1953. RULES OF ORDER WERE SUSPENDED AND BY-LAW READ A THIRD TIME SHORT AND PASSED THIS 1ST DAY OF JUNE 1953.
