BY-LAW NO. 63-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE ANIMAL CONTROL BY-LAW 219-92.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend the animal control by-law to incorporate suggestions from the North Bay and District Humane Society.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 1 (d) of by-law 219-92 to define "At large" is hereby amended by deleting "control" from the last line thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "restraint".
- 2. Section 1(n) of by-law 219-92 to define "Exposed to Rabies" is hereby amended by adding the words "or suspected" after the word "known".
- 3. Section 3 of by-law 219-92 to restrict the use of kennels for breeding cats or dogs is hereby deleted.
