BY-LAW NO. 1982

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize expenditures for the resurfacing of Main Street from Bell Street to Algonquin Avenue, and the construction of a reinforced concrete retaining wall on Fisher Street from a point opposite Fifth Avenue a distance of 158' easterly towards Princess Street.

WHEREAS by authority of By-law No. 1933, the Corporation of the City of North Bay did enter into a "Connecting Link Agreement" with the Minister of Highways, and

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a by-law authorizing expenditure of Municipal funds under the term of said Agreement.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT expenditures of Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred and fifth dollars (\$8,750.00) and One Thousand Seven Hundred and fifth dollars (\$1,750.00) respectively, being the Municipality's share of the cost of resurfacing of Main Street from Bell Street to Algonquin Avenue and the construction of a reinforced concrete retaining wall on Fisher Street from a point opposite Fifth Avenue a distance of 158' easterly towards Princess Street, under the terms of the said Connecting Link Agreement, be hereby authorized as provided for in the current budget.
- 2. THAT the Mayor and Clerk beauthorized to execute the necessary documents in connection herewith and to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
