

BY-LAW NO. 1303

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1298.

WHEREAS BY-LAW No. 1298 is a By-Law regulating the traffic in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend the said By-Law.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That paragraph 9 of the said By-Law No. 1298 be amended by adding thereto Subsection 3 reading as follows:

"The provisions of this section shall not become effective until suitable signs have been erected clearly indicating the restrictions."

2. That Paragraph 12 of the said By-Law No. 1298 be amended by adding thereto Subsection M reading as follows:

"The provisions of this section, with the exception of paragraph 1, shall not become effective until suitable signs have been erected clearly indicating the restrictions."

READ a Second Time in Open Council this 21st. day of November, 1938.

RULED OF ORDER were suspended and By-Law read a Third Time short and passed this 21st. day of November, 1938.
