

BY-LAW NO. 1301

BEING A BY-LAW appointing a day for taking the votes of the electors with regard to a proposed By-Law to advance the time in the City of North Bay one hour during the months of July and August in each year.

WHEREAS there is a proposed By-Law for the Corporation of the City of North Bay entitled a By-Law to advance the time one hour during the months of July and August.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to pass this By-Law for the purpose of enabling the electors to vote on the proposed By-Law.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

The votes of the electors of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall be taken upon the said proposed By-Law at the same time and at the same places as the 1938 annual election for the Municipal Council and the deputy returning officers appointed to hold said election shall take the vote.

On the 29th. day of November, A.D. 1938 at the hour of two o'clock in the afternoon the Head of the Council of the said Corporation or some member of the said Council appointed for that purpose by resolution shall attend at the City Hall in the said Municipality for the purpose of appointing and if requested so to do shall appoint by writing signed by him, two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the proposed By-Law and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the proposed By-Law.

On the 7th. day of December, A.D. 1938 at the hour of 12 o'clock in the forenoon, the Clerk of the said Municipality shall attend at the City Hall and sum up the votes given for and against the said proposed By-Law.

READ a First Time in Open Council this 7th. day of November, 1938.
READ a Second Time in Open Council this 7th. day of November, 1938.
Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law read a Third Time short and passed this 7th. day of November, 1938.
