## <u>BY-LAW NO.</u> 47-94

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 144-77TO REVISE THE MAXIMUM CHARGES.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chap. M.45 s. 220 enables the council to specify maximum charges to be levied upon persons in the Downtown Improvement Area established by By-law 144-77.

AND WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law was published once a week for four (4) successive weeks and the by-law was not passed until the expiry of fourteen (14) days following the day on which the notice was last published.

AND WHEREAS any person liable to a special charge in the Downtown Improvement Area may object to the proposed by-law by filing written notice of the objection with the Clerk of the municipality before the expiry of the fourteen (14) day period following the day on which the said notice was last published.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Paragraph (b) of section 19 of By-law 144-77 is hereby repealed and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

"19. (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this section:

- no person with a business assessment address on Main Street shall pay a special charge levied by the Board of Management of more than \$2,500.00 in one calendar year;
- (ii) No person with a business assessment address which is not on Main Street shall pay a special charge levied by the Board of Management of more than \$1,500.00 in one calendar year."
- 2. (a) Where no person files an objection to this by-law within 14 days following the day on which the notice of the proposed by-law was published, this by-law comes into force as of January 1, 1994.
  - (b) Where an objection is filed to this by-law within 14 days following the day on which the notice of the proposed by-law was last published, this by-law shall not come into force without the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 24DAY OF MAY , 1994.
