THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2005-108

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1963-2100 (OUT OF TOWN MILEAGE RATES)

WHEREAS the Council passed Resolution 2005-340 at its Meeting held May 9, 2005, authorizing increases to the out-of-town mileage rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

- 1. That Section 13. (2)(d)(ii) of By-law No. 1963-2100, as amended, be deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
 - "13. (2)(d)(ii) "Out-of-town" means attendance outside the City of North Bay for the purpose of education or special purpose meetings, but does not include mileage for the purpose of carrying out day-to-day service responsibilities.

By Own Vehicle: An employee authorized by his/her Department Head to use his/her personal automobile in the performance of his/her duties for out-of-town travel shall be paid the following rates: \$0.31/km, effective June 1, 2005 \$0.33/km, effective January 1, 2007

upon submitting to the City Treasurer a certificate setting forth:

- (a) that he/she traveled in his own vehicle
- (b) the actual number of kilometers traveled.

No mileage allowance in excess of 640 kilometers (400 miles) one way shall be provided."

2. This by-law shall come into force as of June 1, 2005.
