BY-LAW NUMBER 741.

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMUNERATION OF THE MAYOR AND THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is expedient to pay the Mayor and the Members of the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay for their attendance at the meetings of the Council,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay attending any regular or special meeting of the said Council shall be paid Five Dollars (\$5.00) for attending at such meeting or meetings. but the remuneration in any case shall not exceed the sum of Five Dollars in any one day.
- THAT said remuneration shall also be paid Members of the said Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay when they are sitting in committee of the whole Council, but in any such case, whether in Open Council or in committee of the whole no Councillor shall receive more than the said sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00), in any one day.
- 3. THAT the Mayor, being the head of the said Municipal Council of the said Corporation of the Town of North Bay, shall receive One Thousand Dollars as his remuneration during his year of office.
- 4. THAT said payments to the Mayor and Members of said Council, shall be payable on the last day of the Months of March, June, September and December.
