BY-LAW NO. 9-91

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND PURCHASING BY-LAW NO. 99-84.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to increase the spending limits provided for in the Purchasing By-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Paragraph (e) of section 4 of By-law 99-84 is hereby amended by deleting the numeral "\$3500.00" from the second line and inserting in lieu thereof the numeral "\$5,000.00".
- Paragraph (f) (i) of section 4 of By-law 99-84 is hereby amended by deleting the numeral "\$10,000.00" and inserting lieu thereof the numeral "\$20,000.00".
- 3. Paragraph (f) ((ii) of section 4 of By-law 99-84 is hereby amended by deleting the numeral "\$7500.00" and inserting in lieu thereof the numeral \$12,000.00".
- 4. Paragraph (g) of section 4 of By-law 99-84 is hereby amended by deleting the numeral "\$7500.00" and inserting in lieu thereof the numeral "\$12,000.00".
- 5. Section 6 of By-law 99-84 is hereby deleted and the following section inserted in lieu thereof:
 - "6. (a) "When goods or services cannot be clearly specified and would result in specific offers by bidders, the Chief Administrative Officer shall issue a request for proposals for consulting services."
 - (b) Where professional consulting services have been provided with respect to the construction of a building, then the Chief Administrative Officer may negotiate an agreement, subject to Council approval, for any renovations to the existing building or structure and he shall have regard to applicable professional association guidelines which may apply thereto."
