BY-LAW NUMBER 584

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 390 OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY, REGULATING THE CLOSING OF SHOPS IN THE SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS A petition has been presented to the Council of the said Town, signed by more than threeOfourths in number of the occupiers of shops of the following classes, within the Municipality, namely:-Grocers, Green Grocers & Fruiterers, Dry Goods, Clothing, Boots & Shoes Bakers, Hardware, Paints & Oils, 5,10 & 15% Stores, Furniture, Flour & Feed, and Butcher--praying for certain amendments to By-law No.390.

AND WHEREAS IT IS DEFEMED advisable to amend By-law No. 390 in accordance with the prayer of said petitioners,

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY, as follows:-

1.

That Paragraph One of the said By-law No. 390 be amended by adding to, and including in, the list of classes, the followin Green Grocers & Fruiterers, Bakers, Clothing, Hardware, Paints & Oils, 5,10 & 15¢ and Furniture Stores, the paragraph as amended to read as follows:-

1. "All shops within the limits of the said Town of Morth "Bay, of the following classes, namely: Groceries, Green "Grocers & Fruiterers, Bry Goods, Clothing, Gents&Furnish "ings, Butchers, Jewellers, Bakers, Flour & Feed, Merchan "Electrical Supply Stores, Boot & Shoe Stores, Paint & Oi "Stores, 5,10 & 15¢ Stores, Fancy Goods Stores, Hardware "Stores and Furniture Stores, shall be closed at thebhour "of Seven o'clock in the afternoon of each day in each "week of the year, excepting Saturday, and excepting the "week preceding Christmas Day in eachyyearaand also excep "ing the evening preceding any Public Holiday, and the "said shops shall remain closed from the said hour of "Seven o'clock in the afternoon, until Five o'clock on th "following marning."

2. That Paragraph Two of the said Py-law No.390 be amended b inserting the following Section "A", after the word "holi day".

Sec. "A"----"All shops within the following classes, namely: "Grocers, Green Grocers & Fruiterers, Dry Goods, "Clothing, Boots & Shoes, Pakers, Hardware, Paints "Oils, 5,10 & 15ϕ , Flour & Feed, Furniture and "Butcher--shall close at One o'clock in the after-"noon of each Wednesday during the months of May, "June, July, August, September and October in each "year, and to remain closed until Five o'clock the "following morning. This Section admits of ma "following morning. This Section admits of no "exception due to the closing of the shops named i "this Section on any Dominion, Civic or other lega "holiday, during the months of May, June, July, "August, September and October, the paragraph as "amended to read as follows:-

> 2. "In addition to the said shops closing at "Seven o'clock each evening as hereinbefore "provided, the said shops are to close at One

o'clock in the afternoon on each Wednesday during the months of "June, July and August in each year; and to so "remain closed until Five o'clock the following "morning, excepting in any such week where the "are closed on some other day in such week "besides Wednesday, by reason of such day being [] "a Public Holiday.

- Sec. "A"---"All shops within the following classes, "Namely; Grocers, Green Grocers & Fruiterers, "Dry Goods, Clothing, Boots & Shoes, Bakers, "Hardware, Paints & Oils, 5,10 & 15¢, Flour & "Feed, Furniture and Butcher--shall close at "One o'clock in the afternoon of each Wednesday "during the months of May, June, July, August, "September and October in each year, and to "remain closed until Five o'clock the following "morning. This Section admits of no exception "due to the closing of the shops named in this "Section on any Dominion, Civic or other legal "holiday, during the monthe of May, June, July "August, September and October."
- This By-law is passed in accordance with the provisions of
 R. S. O. 1914, Chapter 229, Sec. 84.
- 4. This By-law shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.
