BY-LAW NO. 1779.

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to authomize the revision of salaries of Department Heads and Secondary Heads not already covered by Union Agreement.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it necessary that such Department Heads and Secondary Heads not already covered by Union Agreement be governed by a maximum and minimum salary schedule.

AND WHEREAS such Salary Schedule provide for an annual increment until the maximum salary for the position is reached.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay did by Resolution No. 10 passed at the regular meeting held Monday, February 7th, 1955, establish the rates to be effective and the date such rate or rates became effective.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it necessary that such maximum and minimum salary schedules with annual increment and effective date be astablished by by-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Salary Schedule with annual increment and effective dates as referred to in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law be the Salary Schedule for Municipal positions not covered by Union Agreement.
- 2. That the Salary Schedule with annual increment and effective date for the position of Fire Chief as referred to in Schedule "B" be the Salary Schedule for such position.
- 3. That By-law 1704 and all other By-laws inconsistent with this By-law be hereby repealed.
