BEING a By-law to appoint a Fire Chief and setting out the salaries to be paid the several Members of the Fire Department.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Corporation of the Town of North Bay to employ two officers to be known as a Fire Chief and Assistant Chief, and four regular men and four volunteers, and to set out the salaries to be paid the several members of the Department.

THEREFORE the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows;-

1. That GEORGE BRADY be and is hereby appointed Fire Chief.
  - (a) That on resigning his position he must give the Corporation one month's notice. Similar notice except in case or <sup>him</sup> cases of improper conduct must be given by the Corporation, if said Corporation desires to be relieved of his services.
2. That an Assistant Chief shall be appointed by the Fire Chief.
3. That four regular firemen and four volunteers shall be retained and appointed by the Fire Chief.
4. That the salaries of officers and members of the Fire Department payable on the 1st. and 15th of each month shall be follows;-
  - (a) The Fire Chief shall be paid Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.) per annum.
  - (b) The Assistant Chief shall be paid (\$1320) Thirteen hundred and twenty dollars. per annum.
  - (c) Each regular fireman shall be paid Twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.) per annum.
  - (d) Each volunteer shall be paid one hundred and eighty (\$180.) dollars per annum.
5. One quarter of one month's salary shall be retained from each member of the Fire Department, as security for regular payment on fixed dates.

6. That this By-law shall come into effect immediately after the passing thereof.
