BY LAW NO. 1803

BEING A BY LAW to provide for the purchase of a school site and the construction and equipping of a new Secondary School in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board have stressed the need of a new Secondary School in the City of North Bay consisting of twenty-three (23) classrooms, one (1) library-classroom, two (2) science laboratories, two (2) chemistry laboratories, one (1) art room, and one (1) music room, one (1) gymnasium, and one (1) auditorium; such school to be known as the "Rosedale Collegiate".

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the purpose of acquiring lands, constructing and equipping this proposed Secondary School, the sum of \$1,000,000.00.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to provide for same.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the North Bay Collegiate Institute & Vocational School Board be given the necessary authority to purchase the lands, construct and equip the proposed new Secondary School consisting of twenty-three (23) classrooms, one (1) library-classroom, two (2) science laboratories, two (2) chemistry laboratories, one (1) art room, and one (1) music room, one (1) gymnasium, and one (1) auditorium; such school to be known as the "Rosedale Collegiate", subject to approval of the North Bay City Council by Resolution.
- 2. THAT the North Bay Collegiate Institute & Vocational School Board shall forthwith make such plans and specifications as may be necessary for the calling of tenders and for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- 3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the directions of the North Bay Collegiate Institute & Vocational School Board or its architect.
- 4. THAT the Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction pending the completion of it.
- 5. THAT the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of this work shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and the Debenture Principal and the Debenture Interest be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan as approved by the Department of Education.
- 6. THAT this By-law shall only become effective on the final passing after approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Section 67, Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chapter 262, R.S.O. 1950.


