

BY-LAW NUMBER 551

BEING a By-law to fix the Polling Places, appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of the Municipal and Public School Trustees' Elections for the year 1919.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-law fixing polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors to select a Mayor and Nine Councillors to transact the Municipal Affairs of the Town, and also for the election of Public School Trustees for the year 1919.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:-

1. That Polling Place No. 1 for the purpose of the said election shall be in T. H. Winter's Residence 349 Main st W., and T. H. Winters is hereby appointed D. R. O. and ~~Ernie Coleman~~ ^{H.R. Miller} is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said polling place.
2. That Polling Place No. 2 for the purpose of the said election shall be in the Court House and C. W. Deegan is hereby appointed D.R.O. and ~~Ernie Coleman~~ ^{Ernie Coleman} is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said Polling Place.
3. That Polling Place No. 3. for the purpose of the said election shall be in James Palangio's Store 38 Front street, and ~~J. P. Pratt~~ ^{Wm. Hicks} is hereby appointed D.R.O. and ~~H. Hartyn~~ ^{J. K. Garrett} is hereby appointed Poll Clerk, at said Polling place.
4. That Polling Place No. 4. for the purpose of the said election shall be in the Gas House and A. C. Amos is hereby appointed D.R.O. and ~~Ernie Elston~~ ^{Wm. Flannery} is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at the said Polling Place.
5. That Polling Place No. 5. for the purpose of the said Election shall be in the Town Hall, and N. Phelps is hereby appointed D.R.O. and H. C. Clarke is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said Polling Place.
6. That Polling Place No. 6. for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Harry Atcheson's House 66 McIntyre street E., and A. O. Laing is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Alex. Smith is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at the said Polling Place.

7. That Polling Place No. 7 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in the Orange Hall, and G. H. Newton is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Clifton Sheppard is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said Polling Place.

8. That Polling Place No. 8 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Victor F. Russell's residence 29 Regina Street, and Fred Biggs, is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Alcott Tilley is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said Polling Place.

9. That Polling Place No. 9 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in John Richardson's residence 319 Main st E., and John Richardson is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Whitney Brown is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said Polling Place.

10. That Polling Place No. 10 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Ambrose Grieves' residence 478 Fisher street and J. E. Lehman is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Bert Lehman is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at said Polling Place.

11. That Polling Place No. 11 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in the J.P. Quinlan Manufacturing Co's office Percy street, and ~~P. A. Conroy~~ ^{W. H. Snyder} is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Percy Biggs is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at the said Polling Place.

12. That Polling Place No. 12 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in ~~Angelo Chirico's Store 97~~ ^{Jonny Lucenti's House 129} Front street, and C. S. McGaughey is hereby appointed D.R.O. and Gabriel Montemurro is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at the said Polling Place.

13. That Polling Place No. 13 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in E.C. Bebee's Store Cassells street, and D.J. McKeown is hereby appointed D.R.O. and E. C. Bebee is hereby appointed Poll Clerk at the said Polling Place.
