

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 81-70

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 3-69 WHICH PRESCRIBES HIGHER RATES OF SPEED FOR MOTOR VEHICLES DRIVEN ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed limit for motor vehicles on certain highways in the City of North Bay be increased.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Schedule "A" of By-law No. 3-69 be amended by adding thereto

<u>COLUMN I</u>	<u>COLUMN II</u>	<u>COLUMN III</u>
<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>FROM - TO</u>	<u>RATE OF SPEED</u>
Airport Road	a point 500 feet east of Highland Road to a point 140 feet east of Bennett Street	40 miles/hour
Airport Road	a point 140 feet east of Bennett Street to a point situate at its intersection with the westerly limit of the Canadian Forces Base	50 miles/hour
Carmichael Drive	the south limit of the intersection with Airport Road to the south limit of the intersection with Summit Drive	50 miles/hour
Trout Lake Road	a point situate at its intersection with the line between lots 17 & 18 in Concession C and a point situate 300 feet east of Giroux Street	40 miles/hour
Trout Lake Road	a point situate 300 feet east of Giroux Street to the easterly limits of Lees Road	50 miles/hour
Birchs Road	Lakeshore Drive to Highway No. 11	50 miles/hour

- 2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon receiving the approval of the Department of Transport of Ontario and upon final passing thereof.
