



BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, for the appointment of E. R. Valliant, Esquire, as Assistant to the Town Engineer in charge of work in the Town of North Bay, or any work required by the Council of the said Corporation.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to appoint an Assistant to the Town Engineer in charge of work within the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, or for any work required by the Council of the Town of North Bay, and to define the duties of the said Assistant to the Town Engineer and the salary to be attached thereto.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY ENACTSA AS FOLLOWS:/

- 1. THAT By-Law Number 672, appointing a General Supervisor be and is hereby repealed.
- 2. THAT E. R. Valliant be, and is hereby appointed Assistant to the Town Engineer in charge of work within the limits of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay.
- THAT the said E. R. Valliant as assistant to the Town Engineer shall have charge of the men under the Town Engineer's direction, look after their time and do all the bookkeeping required in connection with the Engineer's Department.
- The said E. R. Valliant shall have power to order all supplies, required by the Council and under the direction of the Engineer and shall keep and sheck all equipment, goods, chattels and effects owned by the Council, and shall see that an accurate check is kept of all goods purchased, sold or used by any Department of the Council.
- 5. The said E. R. Valliant shall make a report to the Town Engineer twice each month of all work performed during that time.
- 6. The said E. R. Valliant is to have the necessary assistance of the Stenographer employed by the Town.Council.
- 7. The said E. R. Valliant shall be paid a salary of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month commencing on the 1st day of January, A. D. 1924.
- 8. That By-Law Number 659 of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay be, and the same is hereby repealed.
