BY-LAW NO. 2001-08

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 135-92
BEING A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING AND
MAINTAINING A SYSTEM FOR THE COLLECTION,
REMOVAL AND APPROPRIATE DISPOSAL OF SOLID
WASTES AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITHIN
THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend the by-law for establishing and maintaining a system for the collection, removal and appropriate disposal of solid wastes and recyclable materials in order to prohibit scavenging from the blue box program boxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Solid Waste Collection and Disposal By-law No. 135-92 be amended by adding the following clause 3(5) to the by-law:

3(5) No person shall pick over, interfere with, disturb, remove or scatter any garbage or recyclable material set out for collection. This clause shall not prevent, at any time, the collection of garbage, recyclable materials or other material by persons authorized to do so by The Corporation of the City of North Bay.

2. That Clause No. 10 of By-law No. 135-92 be amended by adding the following penalty clause (3):


10(3) Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than five thousand (\$5,000.00), exclusive of costs and such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.

3. This By-law comes into force and effect upon passing thereof.


READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 22ND DAY OF JANUARY, 2001.
