

BY-LAW NO. 1467

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to provide for the election and Nomination of members of Council and, any Local Board or Commission any members of which are required to be elected by ballots by the Municipal Electors of the City of North Bay.

UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY OF SEC. 65, CHAPTER 60, STATUTES OF ONTARIO, 1946. THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That the election of members for Council and any Local Board or Commission any members of which are required to be elected by ballots, shall be held on the Second Monday in December of each year, and the Polls shall be open from 9 A.M. to 6.00 P.M. for election of Municipal Officers for 1947, and from 9 A.M. to 6.30 P.M. in future years until amended by authority of City Council.

(2) That the meeting of the electors for the Nomination of Candidates for members of Council and any local Board or Commission any members of which are required to be elected by ballots, shall be held on the First Friday preceeding the last Monday in the month of November at half past seven o'clock in the afternoon in the Council Chamber of the City Hall.

THAT BY-LAW Nos. 738-A, 778, and 983 and all other By-Laws inconsistant with this By-Law be hereby repealed.
