CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 973

BY-LAW to authorize the construction of a Concrete Sidewalk on Wyld Street as a Local Improvement under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS The Separate School Board have petitioned the Council to construct as a Local Improvement the works hereinafter described, and the Clerk has certified that the petitions are sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioners in the manner hereinafter provided.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT a concrete sidewalk be constructed on Wyld Street from King to Victoria Streets on the N. S. of Wyld Street in the City of North Bay.
- 2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- 3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions of such Engineer.
- 4. THAT Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation are authorized to cause a Contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation subject to the approval of the Council which may be declared by a resolution.
- 5. The Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the costs of the construction pending the completion of it.
- 6. THE Special Assessment shall be paid by 10 equal annual instalments.
- 7. THE Debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the costs of the work when completed shall bear interest at (5%) Five Per Cent. Per Annum and be made payable within 10 years on the instalment plan.
- 8. ANY person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot without interest forthwith after the Special Assessment Roll has been certified by the Clerk.
