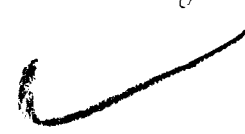

BY-LAW NUMBER 587

BEING a By-law regulating the closing of Barbers' Shops in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Corporation of the Town of North Bay, to amend By-law No. 480, being a By-law amending By-law No. 449, regulating the closing of Barbers' Shops, within the limits of the Town of North Bay,

BE IT ENACTED, and it is therefore hereby enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Town of North Bay, as follows:-

Paragraph One of said By-law No. 449, as amended by By-law No. 480; and paragraphs Two and Seven of said By-law No. 449, be, and the same are hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:

1. From and after the First day of January, 1920, all Barber Shops within the limits of the Town of North Bay, shall be closed as follows:-

- Sec. 1---Wednesday afternoons at 12.30 p.m. during the months of May, June, July, August, September and October of each year.
- " 2---Entire day, all Dominion and civic holidays.
- " 3---Mondays, Wednesdays (except as provided in Sec.1), and Fridays of each week at 7.00 p.m.
- " 4---Tuesday and Thursday of each week at 8.00 p.m.
- " 5---Saturday night of each week at 11.00 p.m.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the preceding Paragraph hereof, all Barbers' Shops within the limits of the said Town, may remain open until the hour of Eleven o'clock of any evening preceding a legal holiday, Dominion or Civic.

7. This By-law shall take effect on January 1st., 1920.
