## BY-LAW NO. 2004-127

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1992-19 (BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT FENCEVIEWERS FOR THE CITY OF NORTH BAY)

**WHEREAS** By-Law No. 1992-19 passed by Council on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1992 approved that each fenceviewer will be paid the sum of \$40.00 per diem under the *Line Fences Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** Resolution No. 2003-735 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting of Council on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2003 authorized that all Council appointees to local boards shall be on a volunteer basis and that all compensation to members of local boards shall be eliminated, effective January 1, 2004;

**AND WHEREAS** Resolution No. 2004-421 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting of Council on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2004 authorized the payment of mileage as of January 1, 2004 for members of the Fenceviewers Committee where those members are required to do site visits in the course of their duties for the Board.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law No. 1992-19 be amended to delete paragraph 2 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:
  - "2. (i) Each fenceviewer appointment shall be on a volunteer basis.
    - (ii) Committee members required to do site visits in the course of their duties for the Committee shall be paid mileage at the current rate paid by the City."
- 2. That By-law No. 2004-017 is hereby repealed.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect as of January 1, 2004.
