

BY-LAW NUMBER 572

BEING a By-law fixing the time for the holding of the Nominations for Mayor and Councillors for the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1914, Chapter 192, Section 64, Subsection 4, Municipal Councils in Towns are authorized to pass a By-law to provide that the meeting for the Nomination of Candidates for Mayor and Councillors may be held at half-past seven o'clock in the afternoon.

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to hold the meeting for the Nomination for Mayor and Councillors for the said Town of North Bay, at the hour of half-past seven o'clock in the afternoon instead of the hours mentioned in sections numbered 63 and 64, Chapter 192.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows;-

1. That the meeting for the Nomination of Candidates for Mayor and Councillors for the Town of North Bay shall be held at half-past seven o'clock in the evening.
2. That this By-law shall take effect immediately after the final passing thereof.
