BY-LAW NUMBER 613.

BEING a By-law to authorize the levying of a rate of taxation for the Town of North Bay, to meet the necessary requirements for the year 1921.

WHEREAS it is necessary that a sufficient amount of money be raised by taxation, to meet the necessary expenses of the Town of North Bay, for the year 1921,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, as follows:-1. That a rate of 23.375 mills on the dollar for general purposes be levied on all taxable property on the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1921, as finally revised and passed.

That a rate of 4.625 mills on the dollar for Collegiate 2. institute purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the junicipality of the said Town of North may, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1921, as finally revised and passed.

 $T^{n}at$ a rate of 17 mills on the dollar for Public School 33 purposed be levied on all the taxable property of the Public School supporters in the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Rodl for the year 1921, as finally revised and passed.

That a rate of 17 mills on the dollar for Separate School 4. purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Separate school supporters in the Municipality of the Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1921, as finally revised and passed.
