IMPORTANT: 3 Strike Policy In Effect Regarding These Guidelines

Failure to follow the guidelines will result in a written 'Strike'. If 3 strikes are given to your group, your contract will be cancelled.

General Information:

- Our onsite staff will collect contact tracing information from all players, coaches and spectators
 upon their arrival at the arena. Proof of double vaccination is also required as per the provincial
 regulations and will be reviewed by our personnel at that time.
- Masks must be worn in the building by players, coaches and spectators.
- Water fountains are not available; however the water bottle filling stations are open.
- No dryland training will be permitted within the facility.

Enter & Exit

- Entrance through Gate 1 (front of building to the left of marquee) 30 minutes before your rental begins.
- Those changing in dressing rooms 2,3,4,5 will exit through Gate 3 (NE corner); those changing in dressing rooms 1, 7 will exit through Gate 2 (NW corner of the building near elevator)

Dressing Room Access

- **30** minutes before the rental
- **30** minutes after the rental
- Dressing room assignments will be posted.
- Masks MUST be worn within the dressing room
- Coaches will change in dressing room 6
- Shower facilities will be available. Failure to adhere to the time limits in dressing rooms will
 result in the closing of shower facilities.
- Players/coaches may remove their mask to put on their helmet. Masks must be put back on when players/coaches return to the dressing rooms/dressing areas.

Spectators

- 50% spectator capacity 2131
- Spectators must wear a mask when entering the building and moving around within the building. Masks must remain on when seated/throughout the ice rental.
- If standing board side or anywhere else in the building, masks must remain on.
- Exit the building via Gate 2 (NW Corner) or Gate 3 (NE Corner).

Important
