

BY-LAW NO.1337:

BEING A BY-LAW to fix the Polling Places and appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of Municipal Elections for the year 1941, in the Municipality of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law fixing Polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors, to select a Mayor and Ten(10) Aldermen(to be elected by General Vote) to transact the Municipal Affairs of the City, and for the selection of Three Public School Trustees, and Two Hydro Commissioners, to be elected by General Vote.

THEREFOR THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT Polling Place No. 1 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in C. Maxwell's Residence, 506 Main Street West, and R. Meikle is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Herb Rowe, Poll Clerk.
2. THAT Polling Place No.2. for the purpose of the said Election shall be in W. Santary's residence, 384 MAIN ST.WEST AND Rene, Mournier is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Wm. Santary Poll Clerk.
3. THAT Polling Place No.3. for the purpose of the said Election shall be in W. F. Roynon's Residence 256 MAIN STREET WEST AND C.J.CORBETT is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Doris Thomas Poll Clerk.
4. THAT Polling Place No.4. for the purpose of the said Election shall be in B.J.Lentz, residence 17 Front Street, and T. Bale, is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Leslie Gale Poll Clerk.

7. THAT Polling Place No. 7 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in W. Russell's Residence 178 Duke Street West, and J. Dunbar is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Wesley Irvine Poll Clerk.
8. THAT Polling Place No.8 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in N. Chaput Residence 171 First Avenue West, and H. T.Relpy is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and C.Larue Poll Clerk.
9. THAT Polling Place No.9 for the purpose of the said election shall be in the City Hall McIntyre & Ferguson Streets and W. Ison is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Gene Brown Poll Clerk.
10. THAT Polling Place No. 10 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in the City Hall, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and W. Cassidy is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and J. R. Bailey Poll Clerk.
11. THAT Polling Place No. 11 for the purpose of the Said Election shall be in the City Hall McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and R. Colbon is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and H. Torrance Poll Clerk.
12. THAT Polling Place No. 12 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in S. Riopelle's Residence 18 Fourth Ave.West and J. Vanier is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Joseph Cosgrove Poll Clerk.
13. THAT Polling Place No.13 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in A. W. Wright's Residence 275 Cassells Street and A. W. Wright is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Mrs. L. Bennett Poll Clerk.
14. THAT Polling Place No.14 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Mr. Newell's Residence 262 Fisher Street, and D.J.McKeown is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Arnold McEwan Poll Clerk.

15. THAT Polling Place No.15, for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Mr. E. C. Bebee's Residence, 399 Cassells Street, and E.C. Bebee is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Bruce McLeod Poll Clerk.

16. THAT Polling Place No.16 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Mrs. N. D. Buchanan's Residence 74 Sherbrooke Street and W. Foster is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Courtney Stewart Poll Clerk.

17. THAT Polling Place No.17 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in P. Mantha's residence 235 WORTHINGTON STREET EAST? AND H.R. Miller is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and W. Forder Poll Clerk.

18. THAT Polling Place No.18 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in J. Wale's Residence 226 Main Street East and E.B. Willis is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and E. Cleminson Poll Clerk.

19. THAT Polling Place No.19 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in C. Washburn's Residence 236 Main Street E. and W. Meecham is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Harry Sharpe Poll Clerk.

20. THAT Polling Place No.20 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in R. Dedman's Residence 313 McIntyre St. East, and J. Mellis is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Roy Gillespie Poll Clerk.

21. THAT Polling Place No.21 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in C. A. Jarvis's Residence 245 Regina Street and W. Baril is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and Mrs. A. Vanreeth Poll Clerk.

22. THAT Polling Place No.22 for the purpose of the said Election shall be in Ray Bush's Residence 314 Regina Street and A. Pigeau is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and C. Blair Poll Clerk.

23. THAT the Railway Employees Express Messengers, Truck Drivers Bus Drivers and Commercial Travellers, Advance Polling Place for the purpose of the Said Election shall be in the City Hall McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and Frank Elston is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer and C. Caley Poll Clerk.

24. THAT the City Clerk shall attend the Council Chamber at the hour of Twelve O'Clock Noon on the 4th DAY of December A.D. 1940 for the final summing up of the number of votes for the Mayor and Aldermen, School Trustees and Hydro Commissioners.
