2066.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH

THIS 16th DAY OF APRIL , 1973.

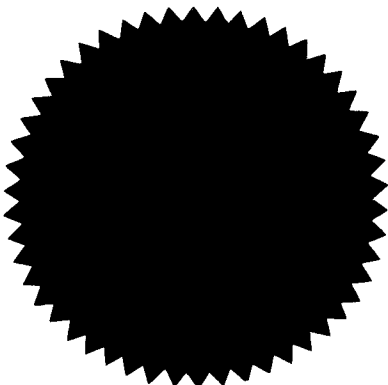
