BY-LAW NO. 38-94

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE PORTIONS
OF STREETS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Canadian National Institute for the Blind, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close portions of Oak Street, Main Street and the Overpass, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the portion of Main Street from Oak Street to the Overpass , Oak Street from Main Street to Murray Street and the west lane of the Overpass in the City of North Bay be and the same are hereby closed from 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 12:00 o'clock noon on Sunday, May 15, 1994, for the purpose of the Roll-a-thon.
2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
3. That prior to 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 15th day of May, 1994, the Director of Transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portions of Main and Oak Street and the Overpass to their condition prior to the above closure.
