

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAYBY-LAW NO. 2283

Being a By-law passed pursuant to the provisions of the Local Improvement Act R.S.O. 1960 Chapter 223 Section 8, declaring it is desirable that the construction of asphalt road surfaces, curbs and gutters on the streets in the City of North Bay as specified and described in Schedule "A" to this By-law should be undertaken as a local improvement.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of The Local Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1960 Chapter 223 Section 8, it is hereby declared it is desirable that the construction of asphalt road surfaces, curbs and gutters on the streets in the City of North Bay as specified and described in Schedule "A" hereto (and which Schedule "A" shall be deemed to be incorporated in and form a part of this By-law) should be undertaken as a local improvement.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

ASPHALT PAVING (no curbs or gutters)

1. Clarence Street from Oakwood Avenue to North End
2. Duke Street from Wyld Street to Fraser Street
3. Princess Street from Ferguson Street to Fraser Street
4. Norwood Avenue from Clarence Street to City Limits
5. Oakwood Avenue from Clarence Street to City Limits
6. Vimy Street from Jane Street to Philip Street
7. Eastview Cres. from McKay Avenue to McKay Avenue
8. Leask Avenue from Queen Street to Judge, Avenue
9. Queen Street from James Avenue to Leask Avenue
10. James Avenue from Memorial Drive to Queen Street.

ASPHALT PAVING (with concrete curbs and gutter)

11. Clarence Street from Jane Street to Oakwood Avenue
12. Nipissing Street from Copeland Street to Jane Street
