THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 43-69

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1113, a by-law regulating and licensing travelling shows, circuses, menageries, circus riding, rope-walking, merry-go-rounds, etc.

AND BEING A BY-LAW to repeal By-law No. 1775, a by-law amending By-law No. 1113

AND BEING A BY-LAW to make applicable the provisions of By-law No. 1113 to the territorial limits of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it necessary to exempt the North Bay Community Memorial Building Commission, charitable and fraternal organizations and service clubs from payment of the license fees as set out in By-law No. 1113 and to establish in lieu thereof a license fee for the carrying on of any of the several trades, occupations, callings or businesses as set out in the said By-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT By-law No. 1775, a by-law amending By-law No. 1113 be and is hereby repealed.
- 2. THAT a new paragraph 2(a) of By-law No. 1113 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay be re-enacted to read as follows:
 - "2(a) (1) Provided, however, that the provisions for the payment of license fees of this By-law shall not apply to the North Bay Community Memorial Building Commission, charitable and fraternal organizations and service clubs, and
 - (2) That in lieu of such license fees the North Bay Community Memorial Building Commission, charitable and fraternal organizations and service clubs shall pay a license fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each day any of the several trades, occupations, callings or businesses as set forth herein is carried on."
- 3. THAT By-law No. 1113 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and all amendments thereto, including the provisions of this By-law, shall be applicable to and shall have full force and effect within the territorial limits of the City of North Bay.
