

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 87-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE DEPOSITING OF SNOW ON ANY HIGHWAY OR BRIDGE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS Section 460 (1) of The Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario, being Chapter 284, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, as amended, empowers municipalities to prohibit the deposit of any snow on any highway or bridge within the limits of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice upon any portion of any highway or bridge located within the territorial limits of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
2. No person shall move snow within the street allowance from one side of the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, to the other side of the street allowance.
3. No person shall relocate snow within the street allowance in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular or pedestrian traffic, or that would result in the obstruction of the normal visibility of the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the street allowance.
4. This by-law shall apply to the whole of the Corporation of the City of North Bay. By-laws Nos. 1854, 1900 and 1958 of the City of North Bay and any amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
5. Any person convicted of a breach of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Judge a penalty not exceeding three hundred (\$300.00) dollars on each conviction and penalty, and costs shall be recoverable under the provisions of The Summary Convictions Act of the Province of Ontario, being Chapter 450, of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, as amended.


READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 8th DAY OF August 1972.
