

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 97-84

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF  
LAND NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL  
PURPOSES. (MILLER)

WHEREAS Section 193 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980,  
Chapter 302 provides that the Council may pass by-laws for  
selling lands no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY  
OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to convey to George Miller, Part 1, Plan 36R-6638 upon the receipt of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay be and they are hereby authorized to execute that certain Transfer to George Miller dated July 17, 1984.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE DAY OF , 1984.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS
