

BY-LAW NUMBER 759.

BEING a By-Law to provide for the construction of Water Mains on certain streets in the Town of North Bay to replace the present water mains.

WHEREAS the present water mains as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-Law, are inadequate for the present service.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to replace the said present Water mains with water mains of a larger dimension, and to extend the existing waterworks system.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Health having inquired into, ascertained and considered the conditions in the Municipality of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interest of the public health that the extensions of the waterworks distribution system be made on the streets set out in Schedule "A" above referred to.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT certain water mains be constructed on the various streets as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, and which forms a part of this By-Law.

THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forth with make such Plans, Profiles, Specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.

THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.

THE Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation subject to the approval of the Council to be declared by resolution.

THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.

THAT Debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum and be made payable within twenty (20) years on the instalment plan.
