BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 135-92 BEING A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING A SYSTEM FOR THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND APPROPRIATE DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend the fees for tipping charges at the Marsh Drive landfill site.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-Law No. 135-92 is hereby amended by deleting Schedule "A" attached thereto and inserting in lieu thereof Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law.
- This By-Law shall become effective March 1, 1993.

THIS IS SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO. 64-93 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

TIPPING FEES

- (1) The City of North Bay shall charge on a per metric tonne basis, the following rates, for waste disposed at the Marsh Drive Sanitary Landfill. (M.T. - Metric Tonne).
- (2) Where wastes may be classified into more than one of the following categories, the wastes shall be deemed to fall within that category to which the higher tipping fee is applicable

(a)	Solid Waste not otherwise referred to herein Subject to a minimum fee per day for waste	\$27.00/M.T. \$20.00
(b)	Passenger Vehicle Whole tires free of rim (per tire price)	\$ 2.00 each
(c)	Clean Fill, Clean Granular Material, Suitable for immediate cover material use	Free of charge
(d)	Solid Waste loads, from Industrial/Commercial/Institutional sources	\$27.00/M.T.
(e)	Solid waste from municipal collection	Nil
(f)	Sludge from Water Pollution Control Plant	Nil
(g)	Solid waste from private vehicles of less than 1 ton and with the equivalent of 6 curbside receptacles	Nil
(h)	Commercial (2000 kilograms) vehicles of less than 1 ton capacity or private vehicles with more than the equivalent of 6 curbside receptacles	\$20.00/load
(i)	Yard and garden waste free of contaminants and suitable for composting	

3. The above fees shall be payable prior to depositing any solid waste at the Landfill Site or in accordance with the accounting system established pursuant to Section 8 (3) (b).
