## BY-LAW NO. 1328:

OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

A By-Law to provide for the submission of a certain by-Law and question for the assent of the qualified electors of the City of North Bay, and to appoint a day on which to take a vote thereon. and to make the places where the votes are to be taken, and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers to take the vote at every such place.

WHEREAS THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY DEEMS

It advisable to submit to the vote of the Electors of the Corporation, qualified to vote on proposed Money By-Laws, a question as to whether the said electors are in favour of securing a supply of electrical Power or energy from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF the City of North Bay enacts as follows:-

- 1. THAT there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of North Bay, qualified to vote on Money By-Laws, the following question that is to say, "ARE YOU IN FAVOUR OF SECURING A SUPPLY OF ELECTRECAL POWER OR ENERGY FROM THE HYDRO ELECTRIC POWER COMMISSION OF ONTARIO?:",
- 2. THAT the votes of the said electors shall be taken on the said question at the following times and places and by the Deputy Returning Officer and Poll Clerks, hereinafter named, that is to say:

The voting shall take place on the 7th, day of May, A.D.1940, from Nine O'Clock in the forenoon until six O'clock in the afternoon.
