

BY-LAW NO. 2150

A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to authorize the renovation and remodelling of the original wing of King George Public School (Harvey Street).

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to renovate the original wing of King George Public School (Harvey Street) by restoration or re-bricking the exterior of building, installing new windows and the complete remodelling of washrooms at an estimated cost of Forty-five Thousand (\$45,000.) dollars, of which Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.) dollars will be financed out of current funds

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to borrow for the said renovation of the King George Public School the balance of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.) Dollars,

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to make application to the Department of Municipal Affairs for said loan of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.) Dollars under the Municipal Works Assistance Program,

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the North Bay Public School Board be given authority to effect renovations to the original wing of King George Public School (Harvey Street) by restoration or re-bricking the exterior of building, installing new windows and the complete remodelling of washrooms.
2. THAT the North Bay Public School Board shall forthwith make such plans and specifications as may be necessary for the calling of tenders, and for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the direction of the North Bay Public School Board, or its architect.
4. THAT application be made to the Department of Municipal Affairs for a loan in the amount of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.) Dollars under the provisions of the "Municipal Works Assistance Program".
5. THAT the Treasurer of the City of North Bay may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of renovation pending completion of such renovation.
6. THAT the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of this work shall be issued and shall be payable within ten years, all in accordance with requirements of the Province of Ontario as established under the terms of the Municipal Works Assistance Program and under authority of the Public Schools Act, being Chap. 330, Sec. 63, R.S.O. 1960, or as amended.
7. THAT this by-law shall only become effective on the final passing after approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Sec. 64 of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chap. 274, R.S.O. 1960.



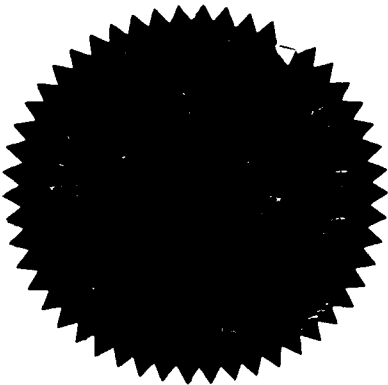

connection therewith; and

(b) that The Corporation of the City of North Bay may pass all requisite by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of debentures in a principal amount not exceeding \$30,000.00, repayable over a term of not more than 10 years, and may borrow money to the extent sufficient to provide an amount not exceeding \$30,000.00 for the said purpose, provided that the corporation and the said public school board in exercising any power approved by this order shall comply with all statutory and other legal requirements related thereto.
