BY-LAW NO. 154-96

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF
PARTIAL RELEASES AND ABANDONMENT OF
EASEMENTS
(MARIAH COURT SUBDIVISION - STREETS & LOT 1,
PLAN 36M-611)

WHEREAS certain Easements over the Streets and Lot 1, Plan 36M-611 are no longer required for municipal purposes and may be released pursuant to Section 191 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., Chapter M.45.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall Release and Abandon a portion of an Easement registered as Instrument Number 99458 and transferred to The Corporation of the City of North Bay pursuant to Instrument No. 319115 with respect to Parcel Streets-1 and Parcel 1-1, Plan 36M-611, being the Streets and Lots, Plan 36M-611, in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, at the expense of the Owner.
2. The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall Release and Abandon a portion of an Easement registered as Instrument No. 218875 with respect to Parcel Streets-1, Plan 36M-611, being the Streets, Plan 36M-611, in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, at the expense of the Owner.
3. The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall Release and Abandon a portion of an Easement registered as Instrument No. 322103 with respect to Parcel Streets-1 and Parcel 1-1, Plan 36M-611, being the Streets and Lots, Plan 36M-611, in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, at the expense of the Owner.
4. The Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby authorized to execute Partial Releases and Abandonment of portions of the aforesaid Easements and to affix thereto the corporate seal.
