

BY-LAW NUMBER 519

Amended by By-Law 51
By-Law # 762.

Being a By-Law to provide for the issuing of licenses to parties keeping Pool or Billiard Tables and Bowling Alleys in the Town of North Bay, for hire or gain.

Whereas it is deemed advisable to pass a By-Law to license and regulate the keeping of Pool, or Billiard Tables and Bowling Alleys when kept for hire or gain, in the Town of North Bay.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows;-

1. That all former by-laws of the Town of North Bay regulating the keeping of Pool or Billiard Tables and Bowling Alleys, when kept for gain or hire be and the same are hereby repealed.
2. That any person or persons keeping for hire or gain any Pool or Billiard Table or any Bowling Alley ^{insert} within the Town of North Bay, shall before opening same to the Public, procure from Town Clerk, a license for the keeping of same, and shall pay the license fees hereinafter mentioned for the said license, and the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to issue such license to any proper ^{person} making application for same and paying the license fee therefor.
3. That the license fee to be paid for each Pool or Billiard Table shall be Twenty dollars (\$20.00).
4. That license fee to be paid for a Bowling Alley shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00 for each bed, in any such Bowling Alley.
5. That all licenses issued under this By-Law shall be annual and shall date from the date ^{of} issue of said license.
6. No licensed keeper of any Pool or Billiard Table or Tables or any Bowling Alley, shall keep open his room in which any such Pool or Billiard Table is kept, or keep open his premises in which any Bowling Alley is kept, or permit any person to play on such Pool or Billiard Table or Tables or in such Bowling Alley after the hour of eleven ²⁰ o'clock on Saturday night, till the hour of eight o'clock on Monday morning and on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, after the hour of ^{with} eleven-thirty o'clock ^{midnight} P.M., till eight o'clock on the following morning.

7. No person or persons licensed under this By-Law to keep a Pool or Billiard Table or Bowling Alley, shall permit any disorderly person or any one who resides in or keeps any house of ill fame, ^{or} any prostitute, to resort to or frequent his house or premises, and no person or persons so licensed shall keep or suffer or permit to be kept in his ^{house} or premises, or in connection therewith, any Ware Bank, Rouge Et Noir Roulette Table, or any device for gambling or gaming, or suffer or permit any tipping or gambling of any kind to be carried on there, or thereupon, or in connection therewith.

8. Every house, place or premises licensed under this By-Law shall be liable to be inspected at all times by Chief Constable, or any Police Officer or other person duly authorized in that behalf; and any person or persons who shall refuse admission to such officer or person shall be subject to penalties of this By-Law.

9. Any person or persons convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-Law, shall forfeit the license and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a penalty not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), exclusive of costs for each offence, and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith, the said penalty and costs or costs only may be levied by distress and the sale of the goods and chattels of the offender; and in case of there being no distress found out of which said penalty can be levied, the convicting Magistrate may commit the offender to common gaol of the Town of North Bay with or without hard labour, for any period not exceeding twenty-one days, unless the said penalty and costs (if any) including the costs of the said distress and of the commitment and conveyance of the offender to the said gaol are sooner paid.

10. This By-Law goes into effect on and after the date passed by Council.
