THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2182

BEING a By-law ratifying and confirming that certain agreement No. 20-M-1 dated the 18th day of July 1963 entered into between the Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board as authorized by Resolution No. 75 of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay dated March 18th 1963;

AND being a By-law authorizing the entering into and the execution of that certain Amending Agreement No. 1 dated October 1st 1964 between the Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board amending the aforesaid Agreement No. 20-M-1, pursuant to Resolution No. 33 of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay dated August 17th 1964.

WHEREAS it is expedient to ratify and confirm the entering into and execution of Agreement No. 20-M-1 hereinbefore referred to;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to enter into that certain Amending Agreement dated October 1st 1964 hereinbefore referred to;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the entering into and the execution of the aforesaid Agreement No. 20-M-1 dated July 18th 1963 between the Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board be hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
- 2. That the Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into that certain Amending Agreement No. 1 dated October 1st 1964 between the Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board amending Agreement No. 20-M-1 hereinbefore referred to, upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the said Amending Agreement No. 1.
- 3. That the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the said Amending Agreement No. 1 on behalf of the Corporation and to affix thereto the Corporate seal.
