# THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

### BY-LAW NO. 11-89

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 2-82 (SCHEDULE 8 - DESIGNATED THROUGH HIGHWAYS, SCHEDULE 13A - SPEED LIMITS, HIGHER RATE, SCHEDULE 14 - SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES, SCHEDULE 17 - TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS).

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 198, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating traffic on highways.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

200 metres West of the intersection with Gormanville Road and McKeown Avenue and 200 metres South of the intersection with Gormanville Road and the South entrance to Canadore College-Nipissing University College.

From a point 55 metres east of the centre line of Lakeshore Drive easterly for a distance of 63 metres.
