BY-LAW NO. 1165

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enter into an agreement between the Canadian Pacific Railway and the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to construct and maintain a water main pipe one inch in diameter under the lands of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company in the City of North Bay for the purpose of furnishing water for the gardens in Lee Park.

AND WHEREAS the said Canadian Pacific Railway have submitted an agreement to be signed by the said Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the agreement annexed hereto and marked Schedule "A" on behalf of the said City of North Bay.
- 2. THAT the said Schedule "A" be and the same is made part of this By-Law.
- 3. THAT upon the signing of said agreement it shall be binding upon the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.
