BY-LAW NO. 2009-250

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC & PARKING
BY-LAW NO. 2002-001(TO PROVIDE
FOR TOW AWAY ZONES)**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS an amendment to Traffic By-Law 2002-01 to provide for tow away zones where official signs are on display was authorized by Resolution No. 2009-638 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, October 5, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 40 of By-law No. 2002-001 is hereby renumbered as 40(1).
2. By-Law 2002-001 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

"40(2) Where official signs are on display, any vehicle found to be parked in contravention of this By-Law may be towed, removed and impounded at the direction of a Police Officer, By-Law Enforcement Officer or the Managing Director of Public Works or his authorized delegates, at the sole risk and expense of the owner of such vehicle."
3. This By-Law comes into effect upon being passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 14th DAY OF DECEMBER, 2009.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2009.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2009.
