THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. **55-79**

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO CLOSE PARTS OF CERTAIN HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ONLY.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of North Bay has deemed it necessary and expedient to close to vehicular traffic only a certain part of First Avenue, located in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS the closing to vehicular traffic only of part of First Avenue does not deprive any persons of the means of ingress and egress to and from his land or place of residence.

AND WHEREAS Notice of this proposed By-law was published for four successive weeks and the Council or a Committee of Council has heard in person any person or their representative who claims to be prejudicially affected in accordance with Section 446 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- All that part of First Avenue situate in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing between the southerly limit of Morris Street and the line which joins the line between Lots 12 and 13 and the line between Lots 18 and 19, all according to Plan Number 69 registered in the Registry Office for the registry Division of the District of Nipissing on the 14th day of April, 1908, be and it is hereby closed to vehicular traffic.
- (2) The Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay is authorized and empowered to erect barricades to enforce the due observance of the within by-law.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 26th DAY OF MARCH, 1979.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED
