

BY-LAW NO. 2184

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-law No. 2004, a by-law to authorize the construction and equipping of an addition to the North Bay Civic Hospital.

WHEREAS as a result of the finalization of plans and specifications and the calling of tenders for the construction of an addition to the North Bay Civic Hospital an additional cost of \$194,332.00 has occurred, and

WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow said additional sum of \$194,332.00 for the purpose of constructing and equipping said addition to the North Bay Civic Hospital as set out in By-law No. 2004.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the 3rd Recital of By-law No. 2004 be amended to include the additional sum of \$194,332.00 so that it now reads as follows:

"WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the said construction, equipping and renovating of the North Bay Civic Hospital the sum of \$1,713,779.16 being the net amount after deducting Federal and Provincial grants."

2. That this by-law shall become effective only on the final passing after approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Sec. 64 of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chap. 274, R.S.O. 1960.


